5.1	Southwark Park - Dogs - Good Owner Campaign

	in the workshops at the Friends Conference on 29 th June.	
5.2	Southwark Park - Dilston Grove	
	The remedial works to the front and side of the wall have been completed.	

5.3	Southwark Park - Sculpture The refer his broad words to the conductor have been accorded.

5.4	Southwark Park - Lake Improvements
