THAMES BARGE DRIVING TRUST

The Thames Barge Driving Event has taken place for the past 40 years. It is the largest annual River Event between Greenwich and Westminster and is now run by the Thames Barge Driving Trust.

Its aim is to promote the historic commercial side of the Thames, encouraging and assisting the apprentice watermen to learn the skills of their watermen and lightermen forefathers.

For centuries these men used their knowledge of the river and rowing skills to deliver cargo from the Port of London to the upper Thames and as far East as Essex and the river Medway.

Over the past ten years we have managed to save and restore twelve of the historic barges, most of them over a hundred years old. They are owned by individual licensed watermen and freemen of the River Thames who fund the maintenance and repairs of their barges on an annual basis.

Thames Barge Driving

Saturday 9th July 1pm start at Greenwich

Line the river front and get your camera ready as the teams drive (steer and row) 30 ton barges over a seven mile course. It's a skilled job to pilot unpowered barges 'rowed under oars' and ride tidal river currents up river.

This event commemorates the lightermen who moved freight this way along the Thames up until the 1930s. It's also a way to recruit younger people back into river trades so come and see some living history!

Southwark Park v Burgess Park



Access information

Bermondsey Carnival takes place in Southwark Park around the bandstand in the north area of the park. It is a combination of large expanses of grass with tarmac paths. There are sheltered areas (marquees) and nonsheltered areas. Weather and ground conditions may be variable. Disabled badge parking, and a drop-off/pick-up point for disabled people is available on site via the entrance on Southwark Park Road. Accessible toilets will be available on site, all of which will be sign posted. There is sign posted information and first aid points located within the same area on the site.

Getting there

Find the best route by public transport via the Transport for London Journey Planner.

Bermondsey tube – 0.3 miles Canada Water – 0.5 miles

Canada Water – 0.5 miles Surrey Quays - 0.6 miles

Bus

1, 47, 188, 255, 381, C10, P12 Canada Water terminal – 0.5 miles

Rail

South Bermondsey rail station - 1.7 miles




