The parks and open spaces concerned are those covered by GLC byelaws. At present these byelaws can be enforced by prosecution. This consultation asks about introducing Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) for byelaw offences in these parks and open spaces instead.

Wandsworth wishes to introduce Fixed Penalty Notices; Haringey and Kensington & Chelsea do not plan to introduce them at the moment, but this consultation would enable them to do so in future, if there is support for the proposal.
