	of the pests and disease on the horizon it is imperative that new species are planted					
	and start to contribute to the landscape so that we can maintain visual amenity we					
	love so much. Within King Stairs and SP there was an opportunity to strategically plant trees to					
	maintain and enhance the land scape, Parks have missed out on planting in any					
	abundance over the last couple of years and this year has seen around 90 trees					
	planted in parks across the borough.

	been planted in a way so as not to impeded the ability to enjoy the view but to also					
	provide some shade as they grow for those that wish to enjoy the view whilst not
