FM Conway have now applied the surface dressing to the paths alongside the carriageway. 	It had been reported that the new Controlled Parking Zone will be in place early in 2016. It was agreed for Andy to ask for a progress report from the Council's Transport team.		
6.4	Southwark Park – Former Swedish Church Boundary Wall		
	The wall has been repaired and an external invoice will be sent to RF London Investment Limited who is the registered owner of the property, with the hope of reclaiming the cost.		
6.5	Southwark Park - Compass / UK Power Networks – Utility Installation Due to redevelopment at the site of the former Decathlon store, UK Power Networks have a requirement to install an 11kv armoured cable between Verney Road / Surrey Quays Road, part of the route will involve laying the cable within Southwark Park between Jamaica Gate and Gomm Road Gate, in February 2016. They have given assurances that two teams will be committed to the works which will be completed within a maximum period of 10 days and that they will do everything in their power to minimise disruption to park users. The trenched area will be reinstated with matching materials and finishes similarly to the surrounding surface. Compass / UK Power Networks have been asked if they would be willing to

They have advised that last time they voluntarily resurfaced the entire path/roadway with stone dressing as opposed to the trench width and have confirmed they would be willing to make a similar donation. 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Attachment 2 - Key Projects Update – January 2016

	Project Description	Current Position
1	Southwark Park south-western boundary improvements In October 2014 we agreed that improvements to the boundary were needed. We asked if the Maydew House redevelopment scheme might provide a solution.	The issue therefore remains of how to improve the south-western boundary.
2	Southwark Park Sports Centre Refurbishment The centre is undergoing a major refurbishment. Works include reconstruction and layout changes of synthetic athletics track, conversion of synthetic turf football/hockey pitch to natural grass, installation of a hammer and discuss cage and the relocation and installation of the following athletic facilities: shot putt circle pole vault runway long/triple jump runway and pit high jump fan and javelin runway Additional works include landscaping to facilitate the these changes and the movement north of the fence at the southern boundary. As a second phase the changing rooms will be improved.	Blakedown Group contractors are on site on the first phase track works which are in the final stages of completion. The new track surface has been laid, and all field event facilities are in place. The central grass pitch and surrounding areas are being completed. For the second phase building refurbishment Faithful and Gould have been appointed Project Managers and they are at detailed design stage. Planned works include the remodelling of the internal areas of the building to support the delivery of athletics track and field activities, and an enhancement of the appearance of the building. Structural investigations are being carried out and a planning application ready for December. The building alterations are expected to be completed by summer 2016.
3	Southwark Park Old Nursery Master Plan In 2013 the Council's CGS Programme awarded FOSP £20k to develop a plan to bring the Old Nursery site back into park use and to also improve the café, toilet and office provision. The aim of the plan was to help secure capital funding. Following public consultation the intention is to proceed with a co-location of gallery, café and office.	Bell Phillips Architecture have been appointed as building architects. Other key events are: • Landscape architects to be appointed by November 2015 • Second phase design consultation completed by February 2016 • Planning approval by May 2016 • Contractor procured by July 2016 • Works completed by December 2016
4	Southwark Park Relocation of 'Family of Dolphins' Sculpture David Backhouse's work was gifted to the Council by Tesco. It was agreed to relocate to Southwark Park lake. The planning application was approved on 12 th May 2015.	F.M. Conway contractors have been appointed to implement the scheme. Kasco Fountaineers have been appointed to install the sculpture on an aluminium sub-structure. The sculpture is now in place and fountains scheduled for February 2016.
5	Southwark Park New Tennis Courts	The works have been completed and the courts were formally opened by Greg Rusedski on 9 th November 2015. The event was well attended with a strong representation of children from local schools.
6	Southwark Park Bandstand Refurbishment The Council's CGS Programme provided £15,000 for improvement works; repainting; cleaning; electrics; surfacing and information board.	The works have been completed.
