| 1 | Southwark Park south-western boundary improvements In October 2014 we agreed that boundary improvements were needed. We asked if the Maydew House redevelopment scheme might help provide a solution. | The Maydew Project Team attended our October meeting to advise on progress, and agreed to come to the November meeting with more detail on possible new park entrance. |
| 2 | Southwark Park Sports Centre A major refurbishment scheme including reconstruction and layout changes of synthetic athletics track, conversion of synthetic turf football/hockey pitch to natural grass, installation of a hammer and discuss cage and the relocation and installation of the following athletic facilities: shot putt circle; pole vault runway long/triple jump runway and pit high jump fan and javelin runway. Additional works include landscaping to facilitate these changes and the movement north of the fence at the southern boundary. As a second phase the changing rooms will be improved, including remodelling of the internal areas of the building. | Blakedown Group contractors were appointed to implement the scheme and Faithful and Gould are Project Managers. Track surfacing and landscaping works are now complete. The infield has been seeded and will be available to use from Summer 2017. The second phase building refurbishment planning application was approved at a planning sub-committee on 4th October 2016. |
| 3 | Southwark Park New Café In 2013 the Council's CGS Programme awarded FOSP funds to develop a plan to improve the café, toilet and office provision. Capital funding £1,650m has been secured and following public consultation the intention is to proceed with a re-location of café and office near the lake. | Bell Phillips Architecture have been appointed as building architects and Kinnear as landscape architects. Design consultation has been completed. Next steps: • Planning approval by winter 2016 • Contractor procured by December 2016 • Works completed by July 2017 |
| 4 | Southwark Park Old Nursery In 2013 the Council's CGS Programme awarded FOSP funds to develop a plan to bring the Old Nursery site back into park use. Capital funding £817,899 has been secured. | Kinnear Landscape Architects have developed a plan for the site. The retention of the existing café building remains an issue to be resolved before plans are finalised. |
| 5 | Southwark Park Current Café Building Once the new café is in place it was proposed to demolish the existing building and landscape over the site. Following a public petition during summer 2016 the Council has agreed to reconsider the retention of the existing café building for community use. | FOSP is to submit a proposal for future use of the building to the Park management by the end of October 2016. |
