Attachment 2 - Key Projects Update - October 2015

	Project Description	Current Position
1	Southwark Park Sports Centre Refurbishment The centre is undergoing a major refurbishment. Works include reconstruction and layout changes of synthetic athletics track, conversion of synthetic turf football/hockey pitch to natural grass, installation of a hammer and discuss cage and the relocation and installation of the following athletic facilities: shot putt circle pole vault runway long/triple jump runway and pit high jump fan and javelin runway Additional works include landscaping to facilitate the these changes and the movement north of the fence at the southern boundary. As a second phase the changing rooms will be improved.	All planning approvals were obtained and Blakedown Group contractors are on site working on the first phase track works which are due to complete by the end of November 2015. For the second phase Faithful and Gould have been appointed Project Managers and a planning application for the improved changing rooms is scheduled for December 2015. The building alterations are expected to be completed by summer 2016.
2	Southwark Park Old Nursery Master Plan In 2013 the Council's CGS Programme awarded FOSP £20k to develop a plan to bring the Old Nursery site back into park use and to also improve the café, toilet and office provision. The aim of the plan was to help secure capital funding. Following public consultation the intention is to proceed with a co-location of gallery, café and office.	Head of Parks gave a report back to FOSP in June 2015. The next steps are: • Appointment of building and landscape architects by October and November 2015 respectively • Second phase design consultation completed by February 2016 • Planning approval by May 2016 • Contractor procured by July 2016 • Works completed by December 2016
3	Southwark Park Relocation of 'Family of Dolphins' Sculpture David Backhouse's sculpture was gifted to the Council by Tesco, Surrey Quays and a new home was sought. A feasibility study led the Council agreeing Southwark Park lake for relocation. Planning application was approved on 12th May.	F.M. Conway contractors have been appointed to implement the scheme. We are advised they are developing a system which will both weight the sculpture and not puncture any lining to the lake. Installation was originally estimated for the end of March 2015 but has slipped. The key issue now is for the contractor to find a design solution to progress the scheme.
4	Southwark Park south-western boundary improvements In October 2014 we agreed that improvements to the boundary were needed. We asked if the Maydew House redevelopment scheme might provide a solution and also reported an offer made by Grosvenor Estates to provide trees.	It was decided to use the Grosvenor trees on the China Hall side of the park and they have now been successfully planted with help from Bede Centre. The issue therefore remains of how to improve the south-western boundary.
5	Southwark Park New Tennis Courts In November 2012 FOSP applied to the Council's CGS programme for two new hard courts. The scheme was approved in July 2013, but additional funding had to be found. In March 2014 MSC Consultants were appointed to progress the scheme. Planning approval was obtained on 13 th February 2015.	Works commenced in July 2015under contractors E.T.C. Sports Surfaces Ltd. The surfacing has been completed. The old courts have also been resurfaced rather than just spray coated as originally planned. The main base coating for both the new and the old courts has been carried out and the final coating was expected in w/b 5 October but weather delayed that. Completion was scheduled for 9 th October but will slip. Opening to public by late October 2015.
6	Southwark Park Bandstand Refurbishment The Council's CGS Programme has provided £15,000 to carry out improvement works; repainting; cleaning; electrics; surfacing and information board.	The works began in early October under contractors PDC and a specialist sub-contractor Multimac to carry out the resurfacing. Estimated completion is early November 2015.
